English activities: Writing an Easter poem

Easy - Write a two-verse poem with rhyming, adjectives and great punctuation

Medium - Write a four-verse poem with rhyming, possessives and adverbs

Hard - Write a six-verse poem in a similar style to a poem you already know

Maths activities: Using fractions to describe a recipe

Easy - write a recipe for your favourite meal - include units for ingredients (g)

Medium - write a recipe for your favourite meal - include units (g), and that ingredient's fraction of the overall weight

Hard - write a recipe for your favourite meal - include units (g and kg) and that ingredient's fraction of the overall weight. You may need decimal amounts for kg.
