Maths activities: Remember that fractions are equal parts of a whole. For example, we can have one half of a whole and one quarter. Which is the bigger amount? It is the half.

Some fractions are the same e.g one half and two quarters are the same amount! We call these equivalent fractions. Equivalent sounds a bit like 'equal'. It means 'the same'.
