Written Statement of Behaviour Principles 2022



Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, learn free from the disruption of others and know that they are precious and loved by God.

All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination.

All of the school community set an excellent example to pupils at all times, emphasising growth through compassion and servitude towards others whilst actively seeking out opportunities to show kindness to others.

Rewards and reflection opportunities are used consistently by staff, in line with the behaviour policy.

The behaviour policy is understood by pupils, staff and parents/carers.

The exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, after careful consideration and outlines the processes involved in permanent and fixed-term exclusions.

Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions and are empowered to flourish.

Together, families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life to ensure pupils shine their light.
